## **ORDINANCE NO. 0-2008-14**

BEING AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING TRANSFERS AND APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE VILLAGE OF WINDHAM AS SET FORTH BELOW AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Finance Committee have recommended to Council that the following transfer and appropriations be made; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Windham declares this an emergency measure for the health, welfare and safety of the residents of the Village of Windham;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Windham three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the sum of \$33,246.24 be, and hereby is transferred and appropriated within the Water Debt Service Fund as follows:

\$33,246.24 from Water Debt Service Transfers - Out # 5721-910-910 to Water Debt Service - Debt Service # 5721-850-7xx retroactively to May 29, 2008.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the sum of \$3.00 be, and hereby is transferred and appropriated within the General Fund as follows:

\$3.00 from Worker's Compensation # 1000-740-225 to Tax Collection Fees # 1000-740-344 retroactively to May 29, 2008.

<u>Section 3</u>: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were accepted in an open meeting of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4:</u> This Ordinance be declared an emergency measure and become effective upon its passage by Council and approved by the Mayor, and to further insure the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Windham.
